Once you see the structure, you cannot unsee it.


In Module this module, we are going to learn to identify what a right actually is, where it ends, and how to recognize the moment law is replaced by injury. We will also discuss:

6. Assessment vs. Tribute: Distinguishing between paying for the common defense of rights and paying for permission to exist.
7. The "Rights Wall": The five structural requirements.
8. The Pocket Test: A mechanical diagnostic to identify a right by asking, "Whose pocket pays?".



Unalienable means impossible to take away, give up, or transfer. It is not a gift from a legislature or a grant from a king. If a right is unalienable, it is a Wall that says: **No Further.**

Example: Texas Constitution, Article 1, Section 29


"To guard against transgressions of the high powers herein delegated, we declare that everything in this 'Bill of Rights' is excepted out of the general powers of government, and shall forever remain inviolate..."

The Wall: By "excepting" these rights out of the general powers of government, the Texas Constitution establishes them as **Absolute**.

The Wire: This provision ensures that these rights do not admit degrees of "mostly" or "except"; they are removed from the reach of the legislature entirely.

Example: Virginia Declaration of Rights, Section 12


"That the freedoms of speech and of the press are among the great bulwarks of liberty, and can never be restrained except by despotic governments..."

The Wall: This is a **Negative** right because it focuses on what the government *cannot* do ("never be restrained").

The Wire: It does not command the government to provide you with a printing press; it prohibits the government from interfering with your use of one.

Example: Massachusetts Constitution, Part the First, Article I


"All people are born free and equal and have certain natural, essential and unalienable rights; among which may be reckoned the right of enjoying and defending their lives and liberties; that of acquiring, possessing and protecting property..."

The Wall: Your right to acquire and possess property is Cost-Free. It requires no labor or expense from your neighbor to exist.

The Wire: If a "right" required your neighbor to fund your acquisition, it would no longer be a right; it would be "legal plunder."

Example: Alabama Constitution, Article 1, Section 1


"That all men are equally free and independent; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness."

The Wall: Because these rights are "endowed by the Creator," they are **Non-Delegated.**

The Wire: They were not granted by the State of Alabama and therefore cannot be "voted out" or "licensed" by the state. Anything that must be licensed is a privilege, not a right.

Example: Texas Constitution, Article 1, Section 3a


"Equality under the law shall not be denied or abridged because of sex, race, color, creed, or national origin. This amendment is self-operative."

The Wall: "Self-operative" is the constitutional term for **Self-Executing**.

The Wire: It does not require a "procedural trigger" or a special act of the legislature to function; it is in full force the moment it is written.


WHERE A RIGHT BECOMES AN INJURY

MAXIM: WHAT COSTS OTHERS IS NOT A RIGHT.

Need does not alter ownership. Sympathy does not relocate the line.

THEFT LINE: NEED DOES NOT ALTER OWNERSHIP

NEED = ~~ENTITLEMENT~~


NEED ≠ OWNERSHIP

Need may be urgent. Need may be compelling. But need does not relocate the Theft Line.


1. If need creates a right to labor, labor is no longer owned.
2. If need creates a right to property, property no longer exists.
3. A claimed right that trespasses is not a right.

The Tension: You cannot create a right for one person without destroying a right in another if the claim crosses the theft line.


DEFINITION: "Law is a rule of right; and whatever is contrary to the rule of right is an injury." (3 Burr. 313).

THE TEST: If a statute authorizes theft, it is not law. It is **Organized Injury.**



The Architects of the Manual

John Locke (The Father of the Circle)
A 17th-century philosopher who established that the individual's "Circle", Life, Liberty, and Property, exists prior to any government.

Frédéric Bastiat (The Identifier of Plunder)
A 19th-century French statesman who identified that when the law is used to take from one and give to another, it is Legal Plunder..

Emer de Vattel (The Natural Law Jurist)
An 18th-century jurist whose work was the primary legal textbook for the American Founders.



Orderly. Procedural. Dangerous.






The Mislabeled Wires: Constitutional Violations

Violation of "Absolute" (Conditional Use): When a provision states a right exists "in such manner as may be prescribed by law." If the legislature can adjust the "manner" of your security, the boundary is no longer yours; it belongs to whoever writes the statute.

Example: Nebraska Constitution, Article I, Section 22

"The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects against unreasonable searches and seizures shall not be violated... but by preliminary examination... in such manner as may be prescribed by law."

The Mislabeled Wires: Constitutional Violations

The Two Definitions of Law

If you use the modern, "mislabeled" definition, the foundation collapses. If you use the definition established in your text, the wall holds.

The "Will Lie" Definition

Law is whatever a legislature passes or a majority votes for.

"Prescribed by law" means the government can change the rules whenever they want.

Result: The right is conditional; the wire is cut; the house falls.

The "Rule of Right" Definition

Law is a rule of right; whatever is contrary is an injury.

"Prescribed by law" means the government must follow the pre-existing boundaries of your Circle.

Result: The right is absolute; the wire is secure; the house stands.

The Mislabeled Wires: Constitutional Violations

Violation of "Negative" (Positive Command): When a constitution declares a person "shall be entitled" to a service, such as timely restitution or a specific outcome. A boundary restrains action; a demand directs it.

Example: California Constitution, Article I, Section 28(b)

"In order to preserve and protect a victim's rights to justice and due process, a victim shall be entitled to... timely restitution from the perpetrators of these crimes."

The Mislabeled Wires: Constitutional Violations

Violation of "Cost-Free to Others" (Extraction): When a "right to the benefits of public schools" is cited. Fulfilling this requires the labor and property of others, making it an extraction rather than a boundary.

Example: Rhode Island Constitution, Article I, Section 23

"The people shall be secure in their right to the benefits of the public schools."

The Mislabeled Wires: Constitutional Violations

Violation of "Non-Delegated" (Granted Power): When rights are described as being "provided by law." Anything issued by authority is permission; if it is created by recognition, it can be un-created by that same authority.

Example: Michigan Constitution, Article I, Section 24

"The right to crime victims' rights... as provided by law."

The Mislabeled Wires: Constitutional Violations

Violation of "Self-Executing" (Procedural Trigger): When a right requires one to be "adjudged" or follow a "judicial determination" before it can be exercised. If you must ask for a determination before acting, the boundary belongs to the judge, not the individual.

Example: Florida Constitution, Article I, Section 14

"Until adjudged guilty, every person charged with a crime... shall be entitled to release on reasonable bail... unless no condition of release can reasonably protect the community."

Labels Do Not Transform Structure

This includes what are commonly called **civil rights** (where they depend on statute), **social rights**, **economic rights**, and **positive rights**. These labels do not transform the underlying geometry.


- Calling a service a right does not make it cost-free.
- Calling a benefit a right does not make it self-executing.
- Calling a program a right does not move it inside the circle.

False rights persist because they feel moral and sound generous, but generosity does not alter geometry. This section does not deny that societies may choose to provide services; it insists only on accurate classification. Mislabeled is not harmless. When benefits are called rights, injury is hidden. When extraction is called entitlement, plunder is normalized.

Precision is the point.

THE DIAGNOSTIC DRILL: THE POCKET TEST

A tool for immediate classification.




If fulfilling the claim requires taking labor or property from another person without individual consent, the theft line has been crossed. The claim is not a right.

Examples are not exhaustive, but illustrative:

- The right to speak: costs no one → passes
- The right to worship: costs no one → passes
- The right to pursue a trade: costs no one → passes
- The right to free education: costs others → fails
- The right to healthcare: costs others → fails
- The right to housing: costs others → fails
- This does not evaluate desirability. It identifies structure.

The test is unforgiving because rights must be.

PRECISION BEFORE POWER



Confusion thrives in vagueness. Clarity creates friction.

The Assignment: Look at your state's Bill of Rights. Apply the Pocket Test. Do not argue. Only classify.
